



**Embroider Design Materials:**

**Lace Leaves Design(s)**

**Ultra Solvy - Water Soluble Stabilizer**  
**Thread & Bobbin Thread (same color)**

**Sharp 11 Needle**

**Paper Towels**

**Bowl & Water**

**Scissors**

**1/8" Decorative Ribbon**

**1/8" Hole punch**

**All Purpose Glue Stick**

**2 Colors of card stock**

**Computer and Printer or a Marker**

**Embroider your Lace Leaves first.**

The images show designs from the Lace Halloween Charms but the instructions apply for the leaves also.



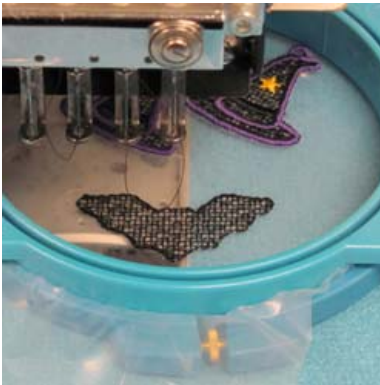
**Step 1:**

Cut a piece of Solvy that is a little larger than your hoop.



**Step 2:**

Hoop Solvy, making sure that it is hooped very tightly.



**Step 3:**

Place hoop onto your machine and embroider the lace design(s) of your choice. Pretend the image above has leaves instead of bats and hats.



**Step 4:**

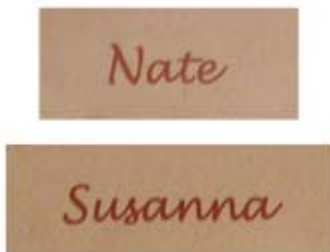
Once the design is done embroidering. Remove from the machine and trim the excess solvy around the outside of the design.

### Step 5:

- Then add hot/warm water to your container. The water should be high enough in the bowl so that the entire lace heart will be submerged.
- Place your lace design inside the container. Let the design soak for about 10 – 15 minutes. This will remove the solvy from the design.
- Remove the design from the water and place on paper towel to dry; making sure that it is flat.



### Make Your Lace place cards for your holiday table.



### Step 1:

Select the color of cardstock that you would like on top. Then on this page either print or write the names of your guests. Then cut them into a rectangle.

Example paper sizes:

Susanna is 2 ¼" wide x 7/8" high

Nate is 2" wide x 7/8" high



### Step 2:

Once you have the names all ready turn them over and apply glue.



**Step 3:**

**Then place them on the bottom page of cardstock so that you have a nice border on all 4 sides.**

Example sizes of bottom cardstock:

Susanna: 2 3/4" wide x 1 1/4" high

Nate: 2 1/4" wide x 1 1/4" high



**Step 4:**

**Punch a hole either in the corner or top middle of the cards.**



**Step 3:**

**Thread your piece of ribbon through the hole in the large leaf.**



**Step 4:**

**Then thread the ribbon through the name card and small leaf.**





**Step 3:**

**Now tie off or place a bow in the rest of the ribbon to finish it off.**
